## Job Description

The Production Supervisor will be located at the manufacturing facility in Basingstoke and be responsible for supervising a team of Team Leaders and their production cells for one complete Site. Our aim is to maintain a safe, clean and efficient workplace where we manufacture products to the correct specification and quality; at the same time ensuring that orders are completed in full and on time.

During normal activities he/she will report directly to the Production & Planning Manager but will have daily interaction with the Production Director.

As part of the role you will be required to:

- Manage Team Leaders and delegate tasks to ensure that processes and resources are utilised as effectively as possible.
- Oversee production ensuring that orders are completed in full and in line with customer requirements.
- Ensure compliance with Quality, Health & Safety & ISO standards; you will be expected to carry out audits, support improvement activities and support external audits/associated actions.
- Manage and ensure your team meet their targets; KPI information accurately, concern areas and discrepancies will need to be actioned.
- Work with and develop Team Leaders.
- Oversee the whole site team ensuring resource is managed effectively including holiday planning, timekeeping, absence and team member performance. Initiate follow up actions where required (Performance Reviews, Discussions, Disciplinary actions etc).
- Support new projects and be influential in their success (5S, Lean Manufacturing). Implement improvement ideas and monitor their value.
- Carry out problem solving and implement countermeasures.
- Liaise with other departments; this may involve attending/arranging meetings to progress actions.
- Lead by example, support and respect your team.

- Implement and manage Team Leader training.
- Deputise for Production Manager in his/her absence.
- Work overtime when requested.
